

16 to 19 Tuition Fund Statement

Additional Support with English and Maths 2020/21

In line with Government guidance, we are publishing this statement to demonstrate how additional funding for 16 to 19-year-old students (called the '16 to 19 tuition fund') will be utilised in the 2020-21 funding year.

As part of our strategy to support students to develop their knowledge and skills, and to bridge any gaps due to the COVID-19 pandemic, we will be providing additional support with English and maths, and general study skills across all our Education and skills Centres this academic year (2020/21).

This will also include additional support for students with special educational needs and disabilities (SEND) - with study skills for the next level of learning.

This is part of the government's one-off 16 to 19 tuition fund. The students supported all need to be those who did not achieve grade 5 or above in at least one of GCSE English or maths by age 16. All supported students must also be on a 16 to 19 study programme.

Learners in need of catch up support will be identified by Tutors/Managers, who will be able to identify and recorded their specific needs. There will be opportunities to engage in small group, live online classes throughout the week.

Learners will also be encouraged to refer themselves if they feel they need additional support.
